RANGITIKEI DISTRICT COUNCIL RECYCLING AND WASTE INFORMATION

What can be disposed of at the Waste Transfer Stations?

Typical household refuse, garden vegetation, old appliances, furniture and tyres.
Recyclables (see over for full list).

What cannot be disposed of at the Waste Transfer Stations?

Car Bodies - Car bodies are not accepted at the WTS unless they are broken down into small manageable pieces (i.e. can be lifted by one person). Vehicles can be offered to a car dismantler/wreckers yard or stripped vehicles can be disposed of at sites out of the district (e.g. Feilding site - Manawatu District Council Ph 06 323 0000).

Asbestos - Asbestos is not accepted at any of the district Transfer Stations. Enquiries should be made directly to Midwest Disposals Ltd, Bonny Glen (see below).

Animal Carcasses Animal carcasses and meat cuts larger than 20kg are not accepted at the district Transfer Stations. Enquiries should be made directly to Midwest Disposals Ltd, Bonny Glen (see below). Amounts less than 20kg will be accepted but must be frozen and plastic wrapped.

Other materials deemed to be hazardous may be refused by the site operator.

Other Waste Information

Landfill Access Bonny Glen Landfill is owned by Midwest Disposals Ltd. Public access is not available, but for enquiries regarding large trucks and special loads Ph 06 350 2976 or 027 2816522.

Kerbside Collection

Budget Waste Removal (Ph 06 344 4201) carry out a private kerbside refuse bag and wheelie bin collection service in the following townships:

Monday – Scotts Ferry, Turakina Beach

Wednesday – Bulls, Ratana, Whangaehu, Crofton (Makirikiri Rd, Neil Dow St and Lawson St)

Thursday – Marton, Turakina, Crofton (Wellington Rd)

Friday – Taihape, Huntermville

Plastic Bottles

Please note it is plastic **BOTTLES** only – **Grade 1** plastic soft drink bottles and **Grade 2** plastic milk bottles and detergent bottles only.

Soft-drink and milk bottles are chipped, washed, melted and made into new products like car bumpers and polar fleece.

NO plastic bags, polystyrene trays or cups, ice cream, margarine or yoghurt containers.

Why? - Many plastic items are made from different types of plastics, which are not easily recycled and cannot currently be recycled by our re-processor.

Please sort carefully into the correct bin. There is no charge for recycling.

Scrap Metal Recycling

Scrap Metal including car batteries and gas cylinders is accepted at all Transfer Stations. Large items not easily handled should be discussed with Scrap Metal dealers who may be able to pick up the items. Contact Strongs Metal Recycling ph 06 354 2974.



Cans and Tins

Steel food tins, and Aluminium cans.

The food tins should be rinsed to prevent odour and flies. Lids should be placed inside the empty cans.

NO aluminium foil or trays.

Once aluminium is collected, cans are shipped overseas for reprocessing. Steel cans are sent overseas and are re-smelted for use in new products.



Paper and Cardboard

Paper and cardboard recycling is available at the Marton and Bulls Waste Transfer Stations.

Recyclable materials include newspapers, glossy magazines, junk mail, envelopes, writing paper, old phone books, egg cartons, corrugated cardboard and thin cardboard i.e. cereal boxes.

Oil, Paint and Hazardous Waste

Oil and other household hazardous waste will only be accepted in small quantities of 20 ltr or 20 kg maximum. All hazardous waste must be given to the Station operator in a secure container and with information regarding the contents. All Transfer Stations will accept hazardous waste.

Agrichemical Containers

Agrichemical plastic containers can be returned for recycling to the Marton and Taihape Waste Transfer Stations. These containers must be triple rinsed. The containers will be recycled into culvert pipes.

Glass

Glass is accepted at the all Transfer Stations. Sorting into separate colours is not required.

Asbestos

Asbestos is **not** accepted at the Transfer Stations.
