KERBSIDE RUBBISH COLLECTION

Taihape and Utiku

Weekly kerbside rubbish collection services in Taihape and Utiku are run by private companies Rangitikei Wheelie Bins (RWBs) and Envirowaste. RWBs provide a weekly collection service for black rubbish bags with RED Stickers and also providers of a wheelie bin service. Envirowaste only provide a weekly wheelie bin collection service.



Rubbish collection services operate every Wednesday (Envirowaste) and Friday (RWBs).

Except Good Friday and Christmas Day, New Year's Day. You will need to check with your provider for their alternative collection day.



Place rubbish bags at your closest collection point, before 7.30am on your scheduled collection day.



To prevent animals getting into your rubbish and making a mess, it's best to put your rubbish out on the morning of collection rather than the night before.

The maximum weight for each bag is 10kg.

Rubbish collection tips:

- Securely close the bag by tightly tying the handles together on the top of the bag.
- Wrap sharp objects and broken glass in newspaper.
- Let any ashes thoroughly cool before placing them in the bag.
- No hazardous waste. (Any type of battery, caustic or inflammable materials).



Items you are permitted to put in your rubbish.

- Plastic wraps and foil wraps
- Disposable cups, plates and cutlery
- Polystyrene takeaway containers and meat trays
- Nappies and sanitary products, wipes
- Broken glass, wrapped
- Kitchen food scraps (If no home composting accessible)
- Soiled paper and cardboard



Items you should NOT put in your rubbish.

- Hot ashes
- Building material
- Large household items
- Chemicals and hazardous items
- Liquid wastes (Faeces)
- Dead pets or animals
- Recyclable items such as rinsed clean cans, glass and plastic bottles (lids off), clean paper and cardboard
- General waste cannot accept batteries causing fires.

If you don't put your rubbish out correctly, it may not be collected.

1. Corner Heron Drive and State Highway One
2. Corner Ruru Street and State Highway One
3. Corner Hautapu and Kereru Street
4. Corner Ruru Road and Swan Street
5. Corner St Margarets Church and Huia Street
6. Corner Wren and Gibbs Roads
7. Corner Rauma Road and State Highway One

Waste can also be dropped off at the Taihape Waste Transfer Station. This includes general waste, e-waste and recycling.
