


INTENTION TO CLOSE ROAD TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

	Right onto Mangatipona Road
	Past Ohaumoko Road (no exit)
	Left onto Turakina Valley Road
	Right onto Mangahoe Road
	Right onto Onga Road
	Past Gibbon Road (no exit)
	Past Aldworth Road
Finish:	On Onga Road at house number 133



Stage Name: Mt Curl Friday 17th October 4.15 pm – 8.45 pm

Start:	On Mount Curl Road 300m from its intersection with Leedstown Road	
	Right onto Warrens Road	
	Past Griffins Road	
	Left onto Galpins	
	Past Warrens Road Ext (no exit)	
	Right onto Makuhou Road at intersection with Tutaenui Toad	
	Past Smalls Road (no exit)	

	Past Smith Road (no exit)
	Left onto Turakina Valley Road
	Past Morgans Road (no exit)
Finish:	On Turakina Valley Road 300m before the intersection with Waimutu Road.



Stage Name : Gentle Annies Saturday 18th October 11.35 am – 5.35 pm

Start:	On Te Moehau Road 300m frin its intersection with Spooners Hill Road
	Past Moawhango Valley Road
	Left onto Erewhon Road (Taihape - Napier Road
	Past Wherewhere Road (no exit)
	Past Burridges Road (no exit)
	Past Makokomiko Road (no exit)
	Past Kelly Road (no exit)
	Past Mangaohare Road
	Past Comet Road (no exit)
	Past Lawerence Road (noe xit)
	Past Willowford Road (no exit)
Finish:	On Taihape Road 300m before the intersection with River Road & Glenross Road.
