

CONDITIONS FOR USING A PARK OR RESERVE

The attached Use of Parks or Reserves Application Form will be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The licence will not be transferable.
- 2. The licensee must reinstate the land to the condition it was in at the commencement of the licence. Reinstatement includes the removal of all rubbish and items/additional resources brought in by the licensee.

A bond may be requested and must be paid prior to using the property. If the property is not reinstated to the satisfaction of the Rangitikei District Council ('Council') or its representative, the bond may be used to cover the cost of reinstatement and any cost over and above the bond will be charged to the licensee. A breach of this clause may affect any future request to use Council property.

- 3. The licensee shall be responsible for ensuring that its employees, agents, invitees and associates comply with the terms of the licence, as well as all relevant bylaws and statutory provisions. A breach by any such employee, agent, invite or associate shall be a breach of the conditions of the licence.
- 4. Noise must be kept to a minimum and/or reduced as directed by a representative of the Council or Police/Security.
- 5. Special conditions may be added as required by the Council.
- 6. The fees and bond (if applicable) must be paid before using the property either by including with this application or, by prior arrangement, making payment no later than two working days before the event.
- 7. The Council may suspend or revoke the licence without notice if the licensee is in breach of any items and conditions of the licence.
- 8. A pre-inspection and post-inspection of the grounds must be organised direct with Council. Please call on: 06 327 0099 or 0800 422 522 to arrange a suitable time.
