<u>RESERVED DECISION OF THE RANGITIKEI DISTRICT LICENSING</u> <u>COMMITTEE</u>

1. Application

Kevin Whiteman made the application on the prescribed form received 2nd March 2018. The applicant has experience (licensee) using the certificate at Bulls Rugby Club, which has a club-licence. The applicant has the required qualifications.

The applicant and inspector refer to a conviction on the 2nd February 2016 for DIC for which the applicant was disqualified from driving for 6 months and had his managers certificate suspended for 28days by ARLA. There has been no further indiscretions and it's hoped the applicant has learnt his lesson.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 227 of the Act.

(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:

(b) any convictions recorded against the applicant since the certificate was issued or *last renewed:*

(c) the manner in which the manager has managed the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to the licence with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm:

(d) any matters dealt with in any report made under <u>section 225</u>.

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 225 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report received 12th June 2018 from the Police.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report including opinion that Kevin Whiteman has managed the certificate in accordance with the requirements under the Act and licence conditions. The inspector supports the application and notes that the application appears to meet the criteria of s. 227 of the Act and has successfully completed a DLC questionnaire.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Kevin Whiteman** meets the criteria to have the Managers Certificate renewed in terms with section 227 of the Act for three years.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for renewal is **Approved** for issue for a period of 3 years.
