RESERVED DECISION OF THE RANGITIKEI DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Oliver Schweikert made the application on the prescribed form received on 17th December 2018. The applicant intends to use the certificate at the River Valley, Taihape, where he has worked for the past 10 months.

The application included the applicant's qualifications, three letters of reference from current and past employees attesting to the applicants experience and suitability to manage the licence.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has not incurred any convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- *(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*

- *(c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- *(d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- *(e) any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition noted within report received 12 March 2019.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Oliver Schweikert** credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge and experience to hold the certificate. The applicant completed a knowledge questionnaire to the satisfaction of the inspector.

The inspector concludes that the grant of the certificate is supported.

4 Conclusion


Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Oliver Schweikert** meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
