DECISION

1. Introduction

This is an application by **Gurbani Cooks Limited** for Temporary Authority in respect of the premises situated at 297-303 Broadway, Marton and currently known as 'Captain Cooks Bar and Cafe'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the first Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence.

2. Application

The application is made against off-licence **037/ON/0021/2016** which has an expiry date of 31st July, 2019.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under the Act.

Police Report – No opposition within report received on 5 October 2018.

Licensing Inspector Report – No opposition within report received 5th October 2018. The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the relevant criteria under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector supports the granting of the licence.

We concur with the inspector's assessment.

4. Decision

Accordingly the application for Temporary Licence is **Approved**, valid for 3 months from the expiry date of the second Temporary Authority or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Licence is approved subject to the conditions imposed on **037/ON/0021/2016** and the requirement that a copy of the Temporary Authority must be displayed, alongside the substantive licence, so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.

The Temporary Authority can be issued immediately.
