Recycling



Glass

Glass bottles and jars can be recycled at all Waste Transfer Stations (WTS) in the Rangitikei District.

The system allows for users to recycle glass according to its colour. Colour sorting ensures used bottles and jars are recycled into new bottles and jars.



Green waste

A green waste disposal service is available at the Marton, Bulls and Taihape WTS.

Green waste is charged at approximately half the actual waste disposal fee – a subsidy is applied to all green waste.

When dropping off green waste, please remove concrete, steel and other non-green waste items.

Scrap metal

A wide range of scrap metal is accepted at transfer stations in the district, free of charge. *Please note a fee may apply if scrap steel incurs handling charges.*

Please ensure items are primarily metal. Site attendants may decide to refuse scrap metal if there is too much non-metal material, such as concrete.

Refrigeration

Refrigeration items incur a degassing charge at transfer stations (\$17.00 per unit).

Gas in refrigeration items contains chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), which is an ozone destroying gas. NZ is a signatory of the Vienna Convention 1985 and as such is required to extract CFCs from any items at disposal, not allowing the gas to escape into the atmosphere.



Other items for recycling

- Tins and cans, washed
- Plastic containers with number triangle 1-6, wash and squash (tops removed)
- Paper free from food scraps and not waxed

e-Waste

Rangitikei District Council is removing electronic waste (e-Waste) from the refuse stream.

e-Waste can be defined as obsolete, broken or end of life electrical or electronic devices. This includes items such as TVs, computer monitors, desktop computers, key boards, servers, printers, scanners, fax machines, photo copiers, cell phones, laptop batteries, DVD and VCR players.

TVs and old monitors contain valuable metals and a large amount of toxic materials such as lead, mercury, cadmium and phosphorus. These heavy metals pose a serious threat to the environment and our health when not removed from the waste stream in a safe way.

There is a charge to recycle these electronic items. A Council subsidy is applied to help cover the costs.

What can be disposed of at the Waste Transfer Stations?

Typical household refuse, garden vegetation, old appliances, furniture and tyres. Recyclables (see over for full list).

What cannot be disposed of at the Waste Transfer Stations?

Car Bodies - are not accepted at WTS unless they are broken down into small manageable pieces (i.e. can be lifted by one person). Vehicles can be offered to a car dismantler/wreckers yard.

Asbestos - is not accepted at any WTS. Enquiries should be made directly to Midwest Disposals Ltd, Bonny Glen (06) 327 5620.

Animal Carcasses and meat cuts larger than 20kg are not accepted at WTS. Enquiries should be made directly to Midwest Disposals Ltd, Bonny Glen (06) 327 5620. Amounts less than 20kg will be accepted but must be frozen and plastic wrapped.

Other materials deemed to be hazardous may be refused by the site operator.

Kerbside Collection

Rangitikei Wheelie Bins carry out a private kerbside refuse bag collection (red) and wheelie bin service in the following townships:

Tuesday - Whangaehu

Wednesday - Marton rural (Whales Line and top end of Pukepapa Road), Bulls and Bulls rural (Raumai Road, around Santoft), Turakina, Ratana, Wanganui Road

Wednesday fortnight (from 25 July 2018) - Scotts Ferry and Koitiata (**red bags only**)

Thursday - Marton residential and commercial

Friday - Bulls, Marton rural, Hunterville, Ohingaiti, Jeffersons Line, Leedstown Road, Fern Flats, Bryces Line, Marton near rural.
