1. When is the next review of the district plan scheduled to take place?

Response:

The District Plan review occurs through a phased approach. Phase 1 with focus on Urban Growth has commenced. We are anticipating public notification of this plan change will occur in late 2024. Subsequent phases of the review have not yet been scheduled.

2. Will there be opportunities for public consultation or community engagement during the review process?

Response:

Yes, the review will follow the process set out in schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

3. Are there any specific key objectives or focus areas that the council intends to address during this review?


