Thank you for your request for information from Council. All requests to the Council for information are required to be considered in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA). Your request for information was received 4 July and related to receiving photos from the public regarding illegal parking. Our response is below:

1. I am wanting to know if the Council accepts photos from the public showing illegal parking on footpaths and bike lanes. If so, what are the requirements for the photos, and are you able to issue infringement fines and/or warnings? Or is it a requirement that your Parking Wardens must sight the offence?

## Response:

Council does accept photos as part of any complaint. For any formal enforcement, staff collects their own evidence, as should the evidence be required for court procedures, it needs to meet the courts requirements of admissible evidence.
