Thank you for your request for information from Council. All requests to the Council for information are required to be considered in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA). 1. Can Rangitikei District council please confirm how it got the \$25,000 figure and what this entails? In addition, does it predict other costs?

Response:

Council has a cost estimate of \$20,000 for the poll. Note: these costs do not include any communications Council would need to run.

This cost is split as follows:

Electoral Officer fee	\$8,000
Additional printing costs	\$10,800
Contingency for price increases	\$2,200
