### Local Government Official Information Request

Thank you for your request for information from Council. All requests to the Council for information are required to be considered in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA). **Question 1:**

"How many alcohol licence applications have received objections during the set period July to June 2024-25?"

Within the Rangitikei District, one alcohol licence application received objections during the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025.

**Question 2:**

"Did those objections come from within the TA boundary?

- If not, where?
- Were these given weight / dismissed?"

**Response:**

Yes, the objections came from within the Rangitikei District (TA) boundary. The objections were given weight.

**Question 3:**

"Numbers of any hairdressers or barbers within the district that hold a liquor licence."

**Response:**

There are no hairdressers or barbers within the Rangitikei District that hold a liquor licence.

**Question 4:**

"Any enforcement action taken against hairdressers / barbers for unauthorised sale of alcohol."

**Response:**

There has been no enforcement action taken against hairdressers / barbers for unauthorised sale of alcohol.

**Question 5:**

“Numbers for any wineries, breweries, meaderies, distilleries that hold both an on and off-licence.”

**Response:**

There are no wineries, breweries, meaderies, or distilleries within the Rangitikei District that hold both an on and off-licence.

**Question 6:**

“Numbers of renewal alcohol licence applications that have been declined based off a relevant LAP.”

**Response:**

No alcohol licence renewal applications have been declined based off a relevant Local Alcohol Policy (LAP).
