For the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, 53% of Council employees identified as women.

Question 2:

The proportion of the Council's employees who are men.

Response:

For the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, 47% of Council employees identified as men.

Question 3:

The proportion of the Council's employees who are another gender.

Response:

For the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, the proportion of the Council's employees who identified as another gender was 0%.

Question 4:

The proportion of the Council's employees who are Māori

Response:

For the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, the proportion of the Council's employees identified as Māori was 17%.

Question 5:

Annual staff turnover

Response:

For the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, Council's annual turnover was 13.4%.
