Revenue and Financing Policy

This Policy, part of the 2015-25 Long Term Plan, sets out how Council will fund all of its activities. The revision contains several changes from the current Policy.

Policy on Development Contributions

Council's current Policy is not to have a policy. It is proposed that the Policy is unchanged.

Schedule of Fees and Charges 2015/16

In general, fees have been increased by 3.0%, the inflation factor used to calculate Council's budgets.

The draft for consultation reflects several decisions by Council, along with administrative changes under the Resource Management Act 1991. The addition of fees around Right of Way applications, extensions to Resource Consents and a deposit for outline plan waiver requests are also included in the draft for consultation.

Four other changes to current charges are also proposed in the draft for consultation.
