Who can make a further submission?

In accordance with Schedule 1, Clause 8(1) only the following persons may make a further submission, in the prescribed form, on this submission:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the proposed plan greater than the interest that the general public has; and
- the local authority itself.

Further submissions **must be served** on the person who made the submission under clause 6 to which the further submission relates by **no later than 5 working days** after the day on which the further submission is lodged with Council.
