Section 4.6 Dividends policy

Rangitikei District Council does not have a dividends policy.

Section 4.7 Policy for funding growth

Rangitikei District Council policy (adopted 16 May 2024) is not to require development contributions. This policy reflects (i) the extent of development occurring in the District and (ii) the view that such a policy might give the District a comparative advantage in attracting developers.

Council’s current network infrastructure is unlikely to need significant expansion to cope with projected residential or business demand.

There are no large developments happening in the district at the moment other than the normal infill subdivisions. The only possible large development (100 lots) that might start in the next three to five years is in Bulls. All new infrastructure and existing infrastructure upgrades will be funded by the developer, and then vested to Council.

This applies to both water and wastewater services.
