### Annual Residents Survey – Improvement Plan

#### Community Buildings

The survey results showed that majority of respondents considered community buildings to be 'about the same as last year' with the least respondents indicating that it was better than last year. A theme emerged in the comments section regarding Council moving to a new premises with 4 comments in support of this and 3 comments not in support, though this was not directly asked about.

Area of Concern	Action Proposed

Complaint about state of the floor (for basketball) in Taihape hall	Have the state of the floor reviewed - comments could be sought from Sport Wanganui to establish whether the floor needs upgrading
