As newly appointed Assets and Infrastructure Chair I have had several meetings with our RDC Assets advisor Arno Benadie, and have taken the opportunity to travel the lower part of our district with Arno and Cr Dean McManaway to view and gain a greater understanding of some of our key infrastructure.

We visited the water treatment plant as well as the waste treatment plant at Ratana, travelled up through the Turakina Valley to Hunterville stopping along the way as Cr McManaway shared his local knowledge of the area; his observation was that overall the route is in good condition with only the one significant drop out. We finished the trip at the Marton water treatment plant where staff took us through the treatment process.
