6 Update on Bulls Town Centre Plan

The date for the 7 Day Makeover for Bulls has now been confirmed for 1-7 February 2016. To ensure the biggest benefit it is important that a wide range of groups from within the community are involved in a collaborative process. There is the need for a member of the community to take the lead in this process, liaising with David Engwicht (who will be facilitating the process) and engaging with the wider community. It is recommended that the Community Committee make this nomination.

Work on the Creative Cubes project from the local youth is still underway. Jan Harris (Bulls Community Development Manager) is now leading this process. The cubes are almost completed and it is proposed that they are installed at the Bulls Domain.

5 Council decision on recommendations from the Committee

The Committee noted that there were no recommendations from the Committee presented to the Council's 27 August 2015 meeting.

6 Council responses to queries raised at the previous meeting

The Committee noted the Council responses to the three queries raised at the previous meeting:

a) Painting of lighting poles in the War Memorial area

Council's roading team was taking this up with Alf Downs (street-light contractor).

b) Replacement town map at the Town Hall

Council's GIS officer was looking into this.

c) Damage to equipment at Walker Park

The state of equipment at all Council parks was currently being audited. Two trees had been removed as they were in the power lines.

The Committee noted the balance of the Small Projects Grant Scheme for the Bulls Ward remains at \$1,184, and that no funds had been allocated to projects to date.

8 Notification of items from previous meeting

The Committee noted that three children were involved in the Youth Project under the Bulls Town Centre Plan.

The Committee noted that the DIY noxious weeds/brambles on State Highway 1 and State Highway 3 was a grey area with NZTA, noting that any clearing of weeds would be inside the 70 kilometre area. A working bee would be organised outside Walker Park to clear weeds on the left hand side of the Park.

9 Upgrade on Bulls Wastewater Upgrade Project Focus Group

The Committee noted that the consent applications lodged with Horizons Regional Council were still on hold awaiting further information. Submissions had now closed on the limited-notified extension to the designation lodged with Rangitikei District Council. One submission in favour of the proposal was received. The decision was due by 16 September 2015.

The Committee noted the update.

11 General business

It was noted that the cross at the gaol site needed to be moved. Ms Thorby to discuss with the churches and ascertain whether the cross could be donated to one of them.

Ms Thorby

- Expressed concern regarding safe crossings for both traffic and mobility scooters. She had identified safe crossing locations. She advised that people in scooters needed to have safer crossing sites. It was suggested that "cats eyes" be installed on the streets to mark the safe areas.

Mr Otto

- The Air Force was releasing houses for sale, however he was not sure of the figures at this stage.
- The Ohakea Air Force would be putting on an air show on 25 and 26 February 2016.
- The Ohakea base was holding a full exercise over two months in October/November 2015.

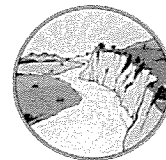

Roading and Footpaths

- 1 Footpath renewal for Hammond Street the design work completed. Tender documents are scheduled for early December 2015.
2. Investigation costs for new footpaths for 136-160 High Street will commence in the 2015/16 financial year.

Water Supply in the Bulls Ward

1. Equipment for the bore water oxidation improvements has been ordered and the electrical installation and configuration is currently being priced.
- 2 The pipe for the filter backwash to sewer mains is being designed to remove existing discharge to the stream.

Sewerage and the Treatment and Disposal of Sewage in the Bulls Ward

- 1 The upgrade for the Domain WWPS ranger control from 127 to 141 High Street is under investigation.

Community and Leisure – Community Buildings

- 1 Project plan for the initial phase is being developed and appropriate resourcing for project management is being investigated for the multi-purpose facility in Bulls.
