For the 2015/16 year, the budget allocation is \$1,184.00. The following amounts have been used by the Committee:

- \$147.83 – Ms H Thorby; reimburse for the cost of paint
- \$78.10 – Ms H Thorby; Christmas lights
- up to \$500 for a shade sail and up to \$150 for plants

Assuming the full provision for the final items are used, this leaves a remaining budget for the 2015/16 financial year of \$308.07.

*Note: change of guidelines allows carry-forward of up to 100% of the annual allocation.*
