

- At an earlier meeting, the Committee sought clarification about walking access along a track through lands now owned by Ngati Apa. The track is shown as an access route in map 63 issued by the Te Araroa Trust (attached)
- The investigation of access through Ngati Apa's land between Beamish Road and Brandon Hall Road has found that the right of access was attached to the forestry licence issued by the Crown. That has been surrendered. There is no legal unformed road through this land, so there is no right of public access.
- I have met with Ngati Apa's Group Manager, Grant Huywler. Ngati Apa is negotiating the sale of this block of land so they do not wish to grant public access through it. I have advised Te Araroa Trust's Chief Executive, asking him to amend the relevant map and commentary so that this access track is removed and the alternative route to Bulls (along Santoft Beamish –Parewanui Roads) is shown instead.
