Did the event go as you had planned? *

The outcome of giving young musicians an opportunity to perform was successfully achieved. We did not get the numbers of performers we had hoped but being a brand new event it is to be expected that many took a wait and see approach.

Students from Ohakune, Waiouru, Moawhango, Mataroa and St Joseph's Schools participated. We were delighted the principal of Moawhango School brought all their students along to support their classmates performing.

We were even able to put in a small masterclass for young brass players, led by our guest judge, PO Colin Clark of The Royal New Zealand Navy Band.

All in all, for a first effort we were very happy. We have had so much positive feedback we will be doing two Junior Bands Rock events in 2026 - one in Ohakune in June and potentially one in either Bulls or Hunterville in July.

What worked really well: *

The parents were very supportive, and the students performed enthusiastically on the day. The support of St Joseph's School Taihape in bringing their classes in to listen was a big boost to our young players.

Some of the newer players were very nervous. Our relaxed approach to getting up on stage worked well for them (and the parents who sat by their nervous debutante artists).

Having PO Clark work with the children was a great inspiration. PO Clark is a regular in the Gumboots tutor family and the continuity of his continued support works well for the development of young musicians.

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

Many of the students did not rehearse consistently, and this showed in the variations in performance skills. A bout of late winter colds and flus knocked our numbers too.

Yes - We had a beautiful day for our event, which always helps. We reduced the number of gardens this time to 7 so people didn't feel so rushed (although the 9 gardens were necessary in 2021 to help avoid congestion during covid!). Our volunteers were outstanding in directing traffic and sorting parking, lunches were hearty and delicious, and the gardens themselves were in peak condition. Our website and social media campaigns were awesome and reached a wide audience. The brochure and ticket packs worked well and our stall holders had a successful day out.

What worked really well: *

The team of people organising the event - everyone has their own strengths, and we utilised these to streamline the preparation. Starting the project a year in advance was necessary to get everything ready for the day and make sure the gardeners had enough time to prepare. Breaking the project into parts and assigning everyone their own tasks made for a successful day!

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

We had hardly any criticism or negative feedback of the event. I think we learnt a lot from the previous event that made it easier this time. No swapping of tickets or organising pick up points last minute this time, which removed a layer of stress. As this event wasn't a sell out that wasn't necessary.

We did have one garden on a narrow country road, and had drivers who didn't know the area. There were a few comments about some questionable driving, so maybe more awareness on the road conditions could have been added to our brochure?
