Did the event go as you had planned? *

Yes, the event went extremely well and was delivered as planned. The evening ran almost 100% successfully from start to finish, with strong participation from designers and models and fantastic support from volunteers, sponsors, families and the community. The quality and creativity of the entries exceeded expectations, with the judges commenting on the very high calibre of the designs. Overall, the event achieved its goal of providing an inclusive and enjoyable platform for people to showcase their creativity and skills.

What worked really well: *

Several aspects of the 2026 Waitatapia Wear-a-Bull Arts worked particularly well. The organisation and running of the evening went smoothly, and the support from volunteers, sponsors and families was fantastic. The standard of the wearable art entries was exceptionally high, with the judges impressed by the creativity and skills on display. The designers and models confidently showcased their work, and the event created a fun, supportive atmosphere where both youth and adults could participate and celebrate their achievements.

Outcomes

Did the event go as you had planned? *

Yes, overall the event went as planned and was successfully delivered. Unfortunately, poor weather had a significant impact on attendance and ticket sales, particularly affecting people who may otherwise have purchased tickets closer to the event. Despite this, the festival went ahead as scheduled, the entertainment programme was successfully delivered, and those who attended provided positive feedback and enjoyed the event.

What worked really well: *

Australian headliner Amber Joy Poulton was a huge success and was very well received by festival attendees. The other entertainers and bands also delivered fantastic performances throughout the weekend, creating a great atmosphere and a strong, varied programme of country music. The quality of the entertainment was a real highlight of the festival, with very positive feedback received from those who attended.

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

The biggest challenge was the weather, which had a significant impact on attendance and ticket sales and was unfortunately outside of our control. For future festivals, we would look at ways to strengthen pre-event ticket sales and promotion so that we are less reliant on last-minute and gate sales. We would also continue to review event planning and site arrangements to ensure we are as prepared as possible for poor weather conditions.

It was great - this was our 62nd, with the first started in 1963 by my late Dad and Jim Norris. With support from Pub Charity, National sponsorship via PGG Wrightsons and Vetmed, RDC Events Sponsorship and lots of large and small donations from local and rural businesses we were able to almost break even. After many years without funds, we always try to maintain a \$20,000 to \$30,000 in reserve funds to relieve stress on our committee members and are just below that at the moment. Entries were slightly down on 2026 at 226 (228 in 2025), that's 150 shearers and 76 wool handlers. Entries have grown 70% since 2018 when we upped the total prizemoney to \$10,000 in order to raise entries

What worked really well: *

Entries continue to increase each year. 2026 was the first year we used a computer app so that the competitors could register and pay before the event using Stripe. This worked well and we were able to do the draws before everyone arrived. This was much better than having to take names and money on the day.

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

We plan to do even better next year with registrations before the event. We do need to try to get our on the day organising to a high level. We finished our event at 7.48pm, which is a long 12 hour day for the organisers, so will try to better that next year. We have been
