1. Reason for Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is provide details for the oral submissions that will be heard by the Council at the meeting on 12 and 13 May 2021.

2. Context

2.1 The Consultation Document (Framing our Future) for the 2021-2031 Long Term Plan was adopted on 12 April and the submission period commenced the same day. Submissions close on 10 May.

2.2 At the same time the consultation takes place on the draft Long Term Plan there is simultaneous consultation on:

- Draft Fees and Charges 2021-2022
- Draft Significance and Engagement Policy
- Draft Revenue and Financing Policy

2.3 To speak at the hearing, a written submission needs to be provided to Council with an indication they would like to speak to the submission at the oral hearing, this can be on any of the matters listed above.

2.4 A full list of submissions will be made available on Council's website on Tuesday, 11 May.
