1. Reason for Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide details for the oral submissions that will be heard by Council at the meeting 19 May 2022.

2. Context

- 2.1 The Consultation Document (Framing 2022/23) for the Annual Plan 2022/23 was adopted for public consultation on 31 March 2022, and the consultation period commenced on 08 April 2022. Submissions closed on 09 May 2022.
- 2.2 Council also approved the following documents to be consulted on simultaneously:
 - Proposed Schedule of Fees and Charges for 2022/23
 - Draft Rates Remission Policy
 - Draft Rates Remission Policy for Māori Freehold Land
