4.1 Hearing of Submissions on Annual Plan, Draft Community Spatial Plan and Simultaneous Consultation

1. Reason for Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide details for the oral submissions that will be heard by Council at the meeting on 11 and 12 May 2023.

2. Background

- 2.1 The draft Community Spatial Plan was adopted for public consultation on 22 February 2023 and the consultation period commenced on 9 March 2023.
- 2.2 The Consultation Document (Framing 2023/24) for the Annual Plan was adopted for public consultation on 15 March 2023 and the consultation period commenced on 23 March 2023. Council also approved the following documents to be consulted on simultaneously:
 - Proposed Schedule of Fees and Charges for 2023/24
 - Proposed Amendment to Rates Remission Policy
 - Proposed Amendment to Revenue and Financing Policy
 - Proposed Traffic and Parking Bylaw
- 2.3 Submissions on all consultations closed at 5pm on 25 April 2023.
- 2.4 To speak at the hearing, a written submission needed to be provided to Council with an indication that the submitter would like to speak at the oral hearing.
- 2.5 As of 4 May 2023, 43 submitters have been scheduled to speak - 17 for the Annual Plan, 18 for the draft Community Spatial Plan and 8 for both consultations. One submitter requested to speak regarding the draft Fees and Charges and amended Revenue and Financing Policy alongside their submission to the Annual Plan.
- 2.6 The hearing timetable is attached (Attachment 1).
- 2.7 The collated written submissions of those speaking at the oral hearings are provided under separate cover.

3. Financial Implications

- 3.1 There are no financial implications to this report. Any financial implications that arise from submissions will be considered at the deliberations meeting on 1 June 2023.

4. Impact on Strategic Risks

- 4.1 No impacts on Strategic Risks arise from this report. Any risks arising from points raised in submissions will be indicated by officers in the deliberations report.
