### Description of Project:

Marton Players is planning to hire a quality Sound System for events + productions at the theatre @ 366 Wellington Road Marton.

Over the past year the quantity and regularity of quality performers visiting our quaint theatre is growing and gaining momentum with many of them planning to re visit in 2019.

Also, we have started a monthly "OPEN MRC" night where local Musos and artists are encouraged to take the stage and perform.
