1. Annual Allocation for 2022/23

- 1.1 The annual allocation assigned to the Rangitikei District Council for 2022/23 is \$24,090.
- 1.2 Additionally, Creative NZ carried-forward the remaining funds from the 2021/22, which amounted to \$24,094.
