Thank you for your attendance today and I look forward to the discussions and deliberations.

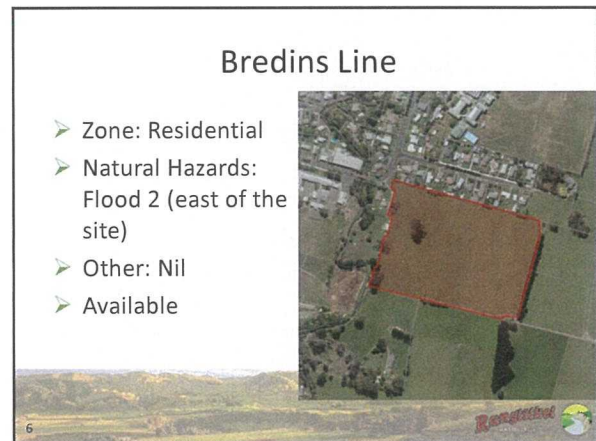
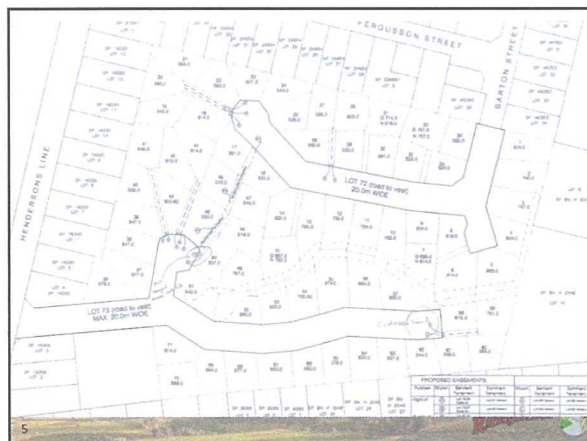
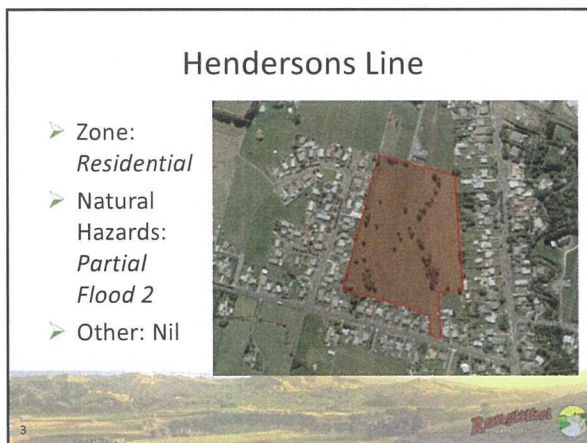
