1 Leaks and Repairs

2 Electricity Meters

2.1 Once more billing data has been received from the new TOU meters, an update will be provided comparing recent with historic costs. Costs are still being assessed.

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3 General

- 3.1 As discussed in the last report, the Ohingaiti break tank has been purchased but still needs to be installed. This is likely to have to wait until the beginning of summer when access is easier.
- 3.2 The Rata pipeline was damaged in the June floods has been scheduled for repair as soon as weather permits and an application has been lodged for funding.
