I am seeking donations for a one off payment to purchase a defibrillator for the Tutaenui hall in Marton. The defibrillator will be in an outdoor cabinet at the entrance of the hall. Any ongoing costs associated with the defibrillator i.e. new pads or glass for the cabinet will be covered by the Tutaenui hall. Currently the closest defibrillators to the hall are at the Z petrol station in Marton which is only available from 0600-2100 and one at the Hunterville police station which isn't available 24hrs a day. The closest defibrillator which is about 10km from the hall. The local community feels that we shouldn't be at a disadvantage to healthcare due to living rurally, which is why I feel it is important to get a defibrillator installed at the hall.

A sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) is when the hearts electrical system goes haywire and stops blood flowing into the heart. A SCA strikes suddenly, anywhere, anytime, anyone even if they appear healthy. Every minute without a defibrillator, the chance of survival decreases by 10%. After 4-6 minutes the brain can become damaged due to loss of oxygenated blood. 8-9 minutes is the average time it takes for emergency services to respond to a cardiac arrest callout. If you look at how long it takes for emergency services to get to a response, how quickly your survival decreases without a defibrillator and how the closest defibrillator is approximately 10kms away from the hall then the chance of surviving a cardiac arrest in the Tutaenui area are very slim.

To purchase a defibrillator and an outdoor cabinet we need \$3455.65, so any donation towards this would be greatly appreciated. Attached is a quote for the defibrillator and outside cabinet. The sooner we install a defibrillator the better, as you never know when someone might need it and the more defibrillators we have the better chance of survival. The Tutaenui hall is going to financially contribute to the defibrillator and we have approached Lions and Rural Women for support as well.

Any donations we receive will be put into the Tutaenui hall account and when we have the sufficient funds we will purchase the defibrillator. We will acknowledge all of our sponsors to say thank you. PARK SEATING

Pip and I met at Wilson Park on 05 March 2018 to have a look at the condition and placement of existing seating with users in mind. We are one of many users of Wilson Park!

The first thing we noticed was the need of bark replenishment at the swing and other play areas of the park. This has since been done in all parks. As we looked around we noticed dead wood in trees and unsafe trees near a seating area. We realised we were there for the seating and dog bins. On a closer look and trial we found you either fell of the seats cause planks on one area has missing or no seat to sit on. If not we were worried about falling through the wood. When trying to reach something in the centre table if the table didn't have pieces missing or sharp nails. Once sitting on a seat it was difficult for both adults and children. My four year old sat on a seat, when trying to reach the centre he couldn't because the table side was missing as well as a bench plank. One looks like a party table broken glass around the base of this and some of the other tables. So a family could not or do not use the seats because of this. Teenagers sit on no seats but most sit on the ground, whale, witches hat or fence. The seats are ideal for a size 12 or less in statue person to sit on if you're lucky. Now if your my size or larger you cannot sit on them as they are narrow width and length wise, rotten or have nails and broken wood poking out of them. I am actually scared to sit on the more flimsy ones. The picnic tables only seat 2-4 people at most, as these are as bad as the seating around the park so it's the ground you land on. While there we noticed dogs running leashed and lead free on the football/rugby fields. There are 2 rubbish bins placed among the play ground and 5 located in the sports field. No Dog poo bins.

I dropped into RDC to see if they could give me any information on seating they purchase in the Region. Sorry no! So I went looking around Bulls Domain. They had metal similar to Citistyle * in Green, a drinking fountain same as what we have in our skate park with two rubbish tin, no dog poo bins.

In the off chance I dropped in Manawatu District Council in Feilding and they were able to furbish me with a book from Urban effects, they use to purchase seating and such like around there region.

As I have a shop I asked people as they came in if they would through the book and see what seating they would like to see in Wilson Park. Most commented they would use the park more if sensible seating was put in. They looked through and they came up with three. I contacted Urban effects to get prices.

Seating Continued

March 13 - Pip and I met at the park to go through the book and see what the locals had chosen. We were surprised that most had selected budget conscious seating. There table/seating selection is varied. Practicality was given to choosing. We came up with Urban Pedestal Table setting which is made of Hardwood Timber slats and frames hot dip Galvanised. It melds well into the surrounds, this is also a table that meets the needs of disabled/wheelchair bound/pushchair/highchair seating at the park. The price is \$2,086.00 or if you want it coloured to match the park play items or the fence its \$2,581.00 hence we are letting you know. The park requires the two existing ones replaced. For individual Benches placed around the play park and rugby fields Woodlands Hardwood Bench \$506.00, we need to do a follow up on where these would be place that was beneficial to park users. As not sure of funding or future plan at Wilson Park I called into the council to see Athol. He was very helpful saying that they use Urban Effects for some of their purchases. I was privileged to learn some basic health and safety around the play ground toys, the bears use Wilson Park as their home ground. We also learned Athol is in the process of pricing Poo bins to purchase and install at Wilson Park due to the high dog traffic. Last contact I had from Athol was he was looking into Stallon Plastics for Poo Bin quotes. Athol had to leave for an appointment. We have yet to book another meeting with Athol as there is some things budgeted for Wilson Park that we ran out of time to share what.

As this is still a work in progress and we need to finalize things. Thank you.
