TV Screen – The Lobby

Following resolution:

19/MCC/002 The Marton Community Committee approve a payment of \$750.00 from the Small Projects Fund to purchase a TV for Civil Defence.

The 65" TV screen has been installed on the front window of The Lobby on Broadway, Marton. The TV is set to run 24 hours displaying Civil Defence & key public notices; being updated fortnightly. Seating Considerations

Following the commitment from the Committee to provide funding from the 2018/19 Small Projects Fund for concrete pads (for new seating) to be installed at Wilson Park; this direction was made to enable seating to be paid for under the 2019/20 Small Projects Fund budget.

For the committee's consideration, the following quotes have been provided to Council staff in relation to other developments within the township. The committee may wish to consider having the seating align with these projects, however that is completely at your discretion.

A summary of the quotes and layouts is provided below (please note: the prices don't include the wood):

Centre Leg - Picnic Table Seating: Quoted Price: \$
1,564 incl GST

(being 'without the wood', 'fabricated', 'galvanised' and 'powder coated black')
This design is suitable for disabled access at both ends.



Picnic Table Seating: Quoted Price:

\$ 948.75 incl GST

(being 'without the wood', 'fabricated', 'galvanised' and 'powder coated black')

This design is suitable for disabled access at ends which have the table top extending 60cm out from the frame. This could be done at just one end or both, or equally just on a few tables.



Bench Seating: Quoted Price: **\$ 384.21 incl GST**

(being 'without the wood', 'fabricated', 'galvanised' and 'powder coated black')

This design is similar in styling as the above picnic table.



I have been in touch with FutureWood NZ who supply 100% recycled sustainable plastics made in NZ, that are becoming more prevalent and last way longer, without any maintenance, rot or having to restrain. Samples will be provided to the Committee.
