Slow speed signage at entrance to Paa

Second footpath along Taitokerau Street

Give Way at intersection Taitokerau and Ihipera-Koria Streets

This has been installed.

Damaged speed hump

This was inspected in April soon after the last meeting of the Board - no damage was evident.

Open drain clearance along Ratana Road

This is being actioned.

Opening up track between Rangatahi and Baggots Roads

A rough order of costs has been obtained (from Higgins) of \$48,000 for a single-lane metalled (i.e. unsealed) road.

Signage for toilets and key availability

The Board Chair has approved the draft wording on sign (for details of his mother's shop) and Council has got confirmation of details for shop opposite. Waiting on final draft (which Cr Peke-Mason Soraya has asked to see).

Graffiti on Kaumatua flats

Cr Peke-Mason confirmed (by text on 26 April 2017) that the graffiti had been painted over.

Replacement rubbish bin outside Medical Centre

The previous bin appears to have been one of the plastic type (that tend to have fires lit in them). Council staff are looking at getting another type installed, which should be during this month.
