chairman's report

The power is on!!

This month the 6 tanks were cleaned inside & out, holes repaired, manhole covers built & fitted, old galvanised pipes cutout and new connections replaced. Special thanks to Paul Geurtjens for all his hard work. We budgeted \$6,000 for this work, costs came in at \$1,465.04. The tank exteriors can now be painted. Colour samples are circulated at this meeting - The top 4 will get testpots and paint squares will be done on the 4 tanks facing Gary Bennett's house.

Other work continued on spraying gorse. A broken post dug out of entrance railing and 3 more posts added as temporary supports.

We continue planning the facilities location on site. RDC have supplied an Aerial graph map.

The Domain is 54 years old this year. Everything we do is linked to telling the Santoff story and ensuring it meets future needs. The entrance, plantings, country heart buildings, artwork, and setting an atmosphere of rustic welcome. We are listening to the Santoff Community and they have been fantastic with their support.

Let's carry on with the next three immediate projects -

- 1) bum up stump heaps & spray lupin around tanks.
- 2) the road entrance & sign.
- 3) Paint tank exteriors.
