6 Reports for Decision

6.1 Allocation of Funds 2022/23

Author: Kezia Spence, Governance Advisor

1. Reason for Report

- 1.1 The Sport NZ Travel Fund is a partnership between Sport New Zealand and territorial authorities to assist the development of junior sport in rural communities, by providing a travel subsidy targeted at young people aged between 5 - 19 years.
- 1.2 The annual funding made available to the Rangitikei District is **\$12,825.00**
- 1.3 Copies of the applications received for the 2021/22 funding round are attached to this report.

2. Eligibility Criteria set by Sport NZ

- 2.1 The Fund guidelines 2021-24 state that funding can be provided for:
 - Rural school club teams or rural sports club teams participating in regular local competition outside of school time.
- 2.2 The following are **not** eligible to be covered by the fund:
 - Rural school or club teams located outside of the Rangitikei District
 - Individual players, coaches or officials
 - Rural school club teams competing in inter-school or intra-school competition during school time
 - Teams travelling to regional or national sport competitions.
- 2.3 Sport NZ have confirmed that travel from the Rangitikei District to neighbouring regions is eligible for the fund, provided that it is for the purpose of *“a regular series of competitions and not a one-off event at the end of the season”*.

3. Applications for 2022/23

- 3.1 Five applications (see attached) to the fund have been received with a total of 805 participants.
- 3.2 The total sum requested is \$18,750
- 3.3 Previously in 2021/22, the Committee allocated the grant on a weighted rate basis (Option 2), providing a 1.5x funding modifier for Hunterville and 2.0x funding modifier for Taihape.

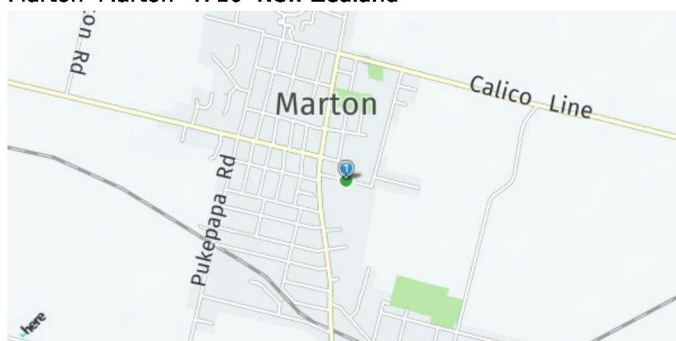

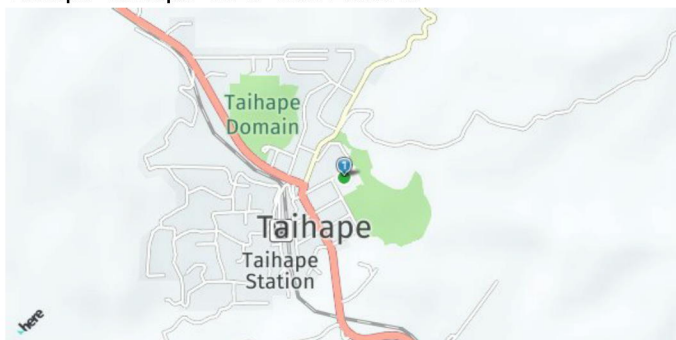

sport opportunities. Our students love sport and there is a high level of 'buy in' for possible participation in sports. Unfortunately, due to our location, every opportunity necessitates the need for travel - usually Palmerston North, Whanganui and as far as the Wairarapa. This puts significant pressure on budget - as the average year costs are in the range of \$12-15000.

When the cost of sports participation is passed on to students, there is pressure put on home budgets - which can be extremely prohibitive and even a barrier to the students taking part. Especially with recent Covid-19 pressures on home budgets, some households are

unable to support their children in sporting pursuits - which impacts the ability of them to participate. Our school data also shows that we live in a significantly financially vulnerable - with our new school equity index of 508 (Decile 1 or 2 under the old system. Most of the subscriptions would be half the cost of travel - meaning that subs are not able to pay for the travel requirement of all sporting codes.

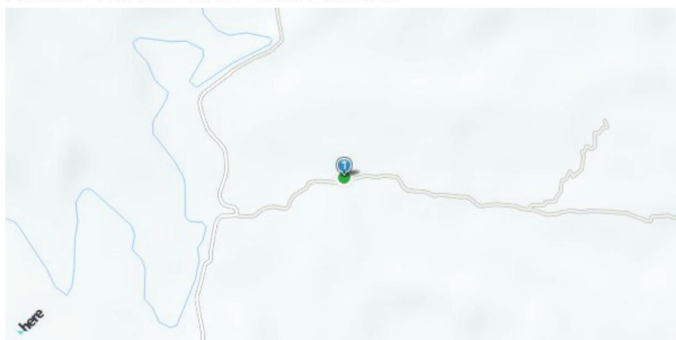

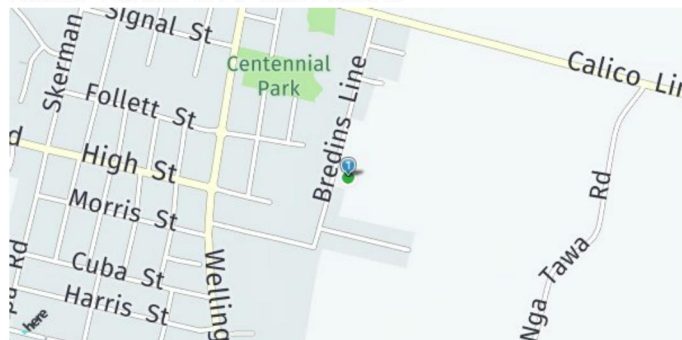

To help support our students with travel each week to the chosen sport they play - including Rugby (Wanganui), Touch Rugby (Palmerston North) Hockey x2 Teams (Palmerston North), Netball x 4 Teams (Palmerston North), Football Team (Whanganui), Archery x45 Students (Whanganui) Cricket Team (Whanganui), Basketball Teams x2 (Whanganui), Volleyball Teams x3 (Whanganui & Palmerston North), Gold Team (Marton), Smallbore Rifle Shooting (Marton), Mountain Biking Team (Regional Events), Moto X Team (Regional Events), Rowers (Whanganui).

Operating 4 vans (the school Board has committed to update our oldest two in 2023) we are able to transport nearly all of our students to regional sporting endeavours. The receipt of the sports travel funding enables us to keep student contributions towards their respective sports as low as possible with fees primarily covering registrations and affiliations instead.

We also offer "Fees Free" Year 9 incorporating sports - year 9 students can try as many sports as they like during Year 9 at no cost (the school covers these costs). Again the Rural Sport Travel Fund assist with this.

We also make our vans available to other schools and community groups at minimal cost e.g. Highland Dancing.

Rangitikei College is bucking the national trend of youth sports declining, as our numbers have grown year on year since 2021 (participants and sports offered), and your support via the Rural Travel fund will enable us to continue to do this. Rangitikei College punches above its weight in sports in the Whanganui region and are regularly held up as an example by Sport Whanganui of a school who is committed and delivering on youth sport management, initiative and delivery.
