# 7 Reports for Decision

# 7.1 Allocation of Funds 2024/25

Author: Kezia Spence, Governance Advisor

### 1. Reason for Report

- 1.1 The Sport NZ Travel Fund is a partnership between Sport New Zealand and territorial authorities to assist the development of junior sport in rural communities, by providing a travel subsidy targeted at young people aged between 5 19 years.
- 1.2 The annual funding made available to the Rangitikei District is \$9,500.
- 1.3 Copies of the applications received for the 2024/25 funding round are attached to this report.

# 2. Eligibility Criteria set by Sport NZ

- 2.1 The Fund guidelines 2024-28 state that funding can be provided for:
  - Rural school club teams or rural sports club teams participating in regular local competition outside of school time.
- 2.2 The following are **not** eligible to be covered by the fund:
  - Rural school or club teams located outside of the Rangitikei District
  - Individual players, coaches or officials
  - Rural school club teams competing in inter-school or intra-school competition during school time
  - Teams travelling to regional or national sport competitions.
- 2.3 Sport NZ have confirmed that travel from the Rangitikei District to neighbouring regions is eligible for the fund, provided that it is for the purpose of "a regular series of competitions and not a one-off event at the end of the season".

# 3. Applications for 2024/25

- 3.1 Six eligible applications (see attached) to the fund have been received with a total of 510 participants.
- 3.2 The total sum requested is \$27,700, noting that officers have assumed the \$1500 request for the Marton Bears Netball Club.
- 3.3 Previously in 2023/24 the Committee allocated the grant with a resolution taking into consideration the applied amount from the organisations.
- 3.4 Prior to this the Committee allocated the grant on a flat rate per participant (Option 1) and a weighted rate basis (Option 2), providing a 1.5x funding modifier for Hunterville and 2.0x funding modifier for Taihape.

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The funding will be used to cover transport costs and logistics, ensuring all our tamariki have access to after-school sports without financial barriers. Our kura has experienced major roll growth, with more students eager to participate in rugby, netball, and touch. However, as a small rural kura, getting our teams to and from local competitions and training sessions remains a significant challenge for many whānau.

Our teams participate in regular local sports competitions outside of school hours, and the funding will help cover transport costs for these events, as well as training sessions essential for skill development. Transport is a major barrier to participation; our teams travel nearly 20km one way just to attend local town competitions, along with varying distances to other rural schools' events. With increasing team sizes and the need for ongoing vehicle maintenance, these costs quickly add up.

Although our kura may appear to be in a good financial position, we have been funding an extra teacher to accommodate our roll growth and have been providing a full complimentary bus service for our town whānau, which has stretched our resources. Additionally, we have contributed towards a classroom upgrade, resulting in a current financial deficit.

We are applying for \$6,000 to cover transport costs and ensure the sustainability of our sports program, addressing increasing travel demands and vehicle upkeep. This funding would ensure that all tamariki, regardless of financial or geographical barriers, can participate in sports, develop their skills, and proudly represent our kura.

Operating 4 vans (which the school Board has committed to keep updated) we are able to transport nearly all of our students to regional sporting endeavours. The receipt of the sports travel funding enables us to deliver "fees free sport" to our students with the school board funding all the registration costs, uniforms and equipment, and the balance of travel expenses. This is part of our "No Limits" offering to our students - they can play as many sports as they like without the financial burden on their families, many of which cannot afford sport fees. 
