On 22 November 2016, Council held a strategic planning day with an external facilitator. Six priority issues were confirmed:

- 1. Infrastructural service levels
- 2. Economic development
- 3. Future looking community facilities
- 4. Earthquake-prone buildings
- 5. Communication/engagement and collaboration
- 6. Rates level/affordability/value

Council is currently finalising the list of identified projects to address these issues and has asked that Te Roopu Ahi Kaa to be informed of where these have a directly lwi/Maori content – and to invite the Komiti's comment.

The relevant projects are:

Economic development	Unlock Maori land-locked land
	Council wants the District to derive maximum benefit from the regional growth study (and the associated Te Pae Tawhiti). It looks for collaborative opportunities with lwi.
Communication/engagement and	Iwi participation on Council committees
collaboration	Bilingual signage at Council
	Identify optimal structures for engaging and collaborating with people of different ages, ethnicity and circumstances including Maori outside Te Roopu Ahi Kaa
