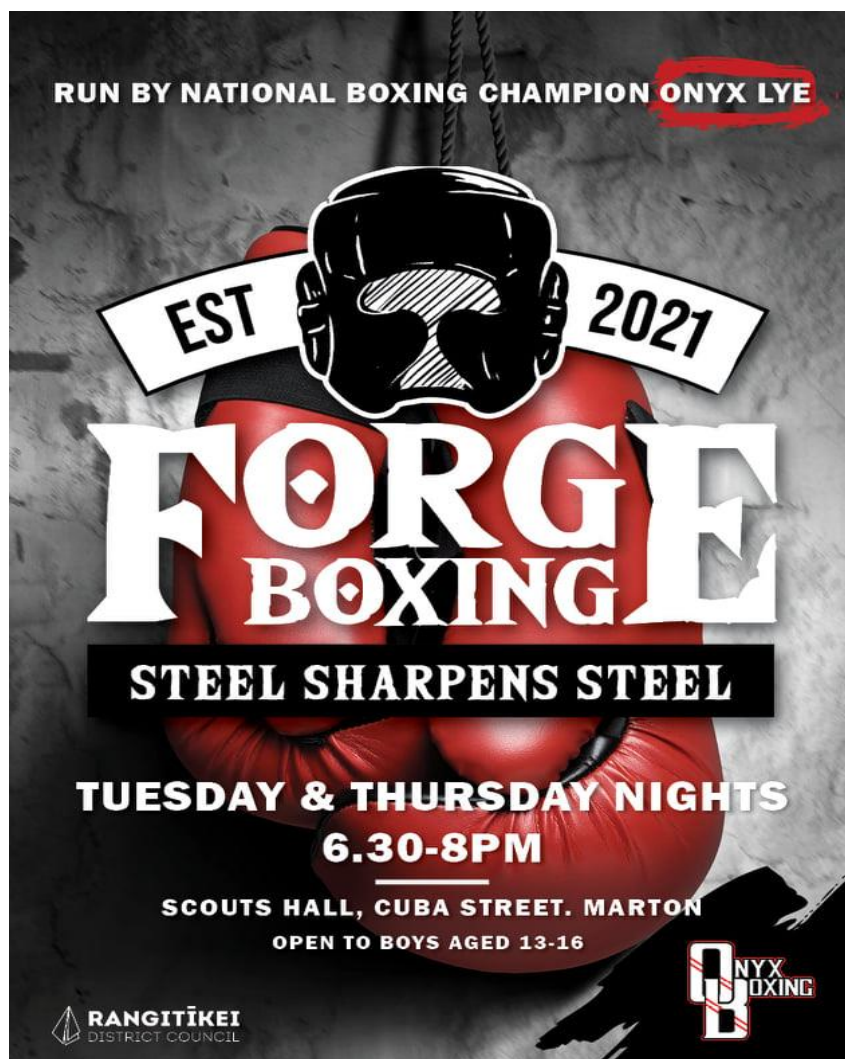
7.1 Youth Council Report - May/June 2021

The boys one has been up and running a month now, with a solid number that turn up every week, girls running two weeks and will keep growing as more people learn about it. I want to start adult boxfit classes too, so looking for a trainer to run that, to keep the youth ones free, self sustainable. I know this isn't a youth council initiative, but it does involve your fellow youth, so it does involve you too, plus it fits in with your work plan around how to include younger youth and look after those who fall through the cracks.
