Notice of Renewal of Licence

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

To: BRH Holdings Ltd

The Off Licence in respect of the premises situated at 120 Hautapu Street, Taihape and known as "Taihape Liquorland" is renewed.

The present conditions of the licence continue to apply subject to the following changes:

- (a) There will be no single sales of alcohol in containers less than 330mls. This restriction does not apply to individual handcrafted beers in single bottles/cans or multi-serve sizes of 330ml or higher.
- (b) No single sales of Ready to Drink (RTD's) are permitted. A Minimum sale of 4 per purchase.
- (c) Alcohol may only be sold in the original form it was received i.e. packs of 4, 6, 12, 18, or 24. Except where packaging has become broken or damaged (unrecoverable), those items may be repacked and sold in packs of at least four.
- (d) Premium beer and cider products, products in a vessel measuring 330mls or greater, can be sold as a single unit.
- (e) Signage, as required under the Act, must be displayed and visible to the public.
- (f) A manager's register (as required by s.232 of the Act) is to be maintained and available on site. It must be up-to-date with all Duty Managers current certificates and expiry dates.
- (g) On-going education must be provided to staff / volunteers / committee members at least yearly and logged in training register.
- (h) Incidents, whether significant or not, must be recorded in an incident log (this maybe in a diary or notebook or use toolkit).
- (i) External advertising on the front of the building must be less than 50% coverage of the front wall.
- (j)

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence continues in force:

- Until the close of the period for which it is renewed (24 March 2028); or
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the expiry date of **24 March 2028**.

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sales and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

DLC Ref: 037/OFF/0012/2016

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), BRH Holdings Ltd (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 120 Hautapu Street, Taihape and known as Taihape Liquorland, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
- (b) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
- (c)

Monday - Saturday 9:00am - 10:00pm

Sunday 10:00am - 8:00pm

- (d) the whole of the premises is designated as a restricted area.
- (e) There will be no single sales of alcohol in containers less than 330mls. This restriction does not apply to individual handcrafted beers in single bottles/cans or multi-serve sizes of 330ml or higher.
- (f) No single sales of Ready to Drink (RTD's) are permitted. A Minimum sale of 4 per purchase.
- (g) Alcohol may only be sold in the original form it was received i.e. packs of 4, 6, 12, 18, or 24. Except where packaging has become broken or damaged (unrecoverable), those items may be repacked and sold in packs of at least four.
- (h) Premium beer and cider products, products in a vessel measuring 330mls or greater, can be sold as a single unit.
- (i) Signage, as required under the Act, must be displayed and visible to the public.
- (j) A manager's register (as required by s.232 of the Act) is to be maintained and available on site. It must be up-to-date with all Duty Managers current certificates and expiry dates.

Duration

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
 - (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
- (iii) This licence expires 24 March 2028**

Off-Licence

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sales and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

DLC Ref: 37/OFF/0019/2021

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Pssr Family Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 107 Hautapu Street, Taihape and known as Quick Stop Grocery & More, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Endorsement

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday – Sunday 7:30am – 9:00pm
- (c) the only area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol and is Undesignated.
- (d) The licensee must ensure that for each principal entrance to the premises there is displayed at all times a sign attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises are open for the sale of alcohol.
- (e) The licensee and managers on duty must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons
- The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed - attached to the inside of the premises concerned; and so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.
- (f) Drinking water must be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time
- (g) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises unless it contains no more than 15% ethanol by volume measured at 20°C and is—
 - (a) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (b) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (c) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine (however that product may be described in the standard); or
 - (d) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine (however that product may be described in the standard); or
 - (e) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (h) In accordance with s. 113 of the Act, the **Single Alcohol Area**, as delineated on the application renewal file, is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol.. The whole of the premises is **'undesigned'**

Duration: Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
- (iii) This licence expires 19 April 2028**
