**Local Government Official Information Request**

Thank you for your request for information from Council. All requests to the Council for information are required to be considered in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA). Your request for information was received on 14 March 2025 and related to raised pedestrian crossings. Our response is below:

1. When did you build your first raised pedestrian crossing, and why? (As opposed to a standard zebra crossing)

**Response:**

In the Rangitikei District, four raised pedestrian zebra crossings were installed prior to 2000, to slow vehicles down prior to entering a CBD.

2. How many have you built since?

**Response:**

The Rangitikei District Council has built one pedestrian crossing since, it is raised, but it is not a zebra crossing. Pedestrians must give way to vehicles for this one.

3. In the past 5 years, how many pedestrians have been injured on traditional zebra crossings in your area?

**Response:**

There has been one pedestrian injured on a traditional zebra crossing in the past 5 years in the Rangitikei District.

4. In the past 5 years, how many pedestrians have been injured on raised pedestrian crossings in your area?

**Response:**

There have been no pedestrians injured on a raised pedestrian crossing in the past 5 years in the Rangitikei District.
